In the spring of 2019, the Paddock Mansion's roof suffered a severe leak. forcing the museum staff and volunteers to relocate a portion large artifacts, paintings, and clothing in order to protect them from the incoming rain. A

project long time in coming, this leak has forced the JCHS into the process of replacing the entire 1878 Paddock Mansion roof.

With the help of approximately \$1.1 million already raised, the contracts are in place for the project to begin, but this still leaves about \$50,000 to be raised just to cover the cost of this project.

<u>ACCESS</u>

As a facility, JCHS lacks a lot of the modern amenities to facilitate our physically challenged or aging visitors' ability to enjoy all that the Paddock Mansion has to offer. Much of the displays open to the public reside on the 2nd floor and in the basement, neither of which are currently handicap accessible. With the funds raised through this Capital Campaign, JCHS will be able to install an elevator, allowing full access to all of the museum's great offerings.
